The IOAA is hosting their 2nd Annual Artists Retreat at **Big Rock Camp and Campground** near Gypsumville.

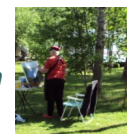
The instructor will be Graham Clarke from Inwood Manitoba.

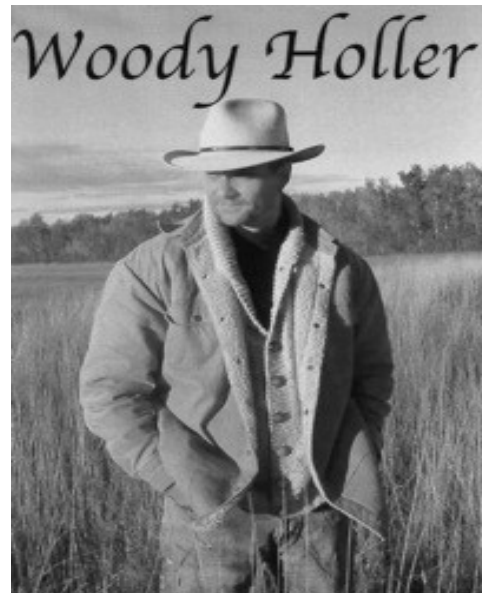
